Description of the organisation looking for partners and role in the project	ANTIC (agency for the new technologies of information and communication) was founded in 1999 as a non-profit organization to develop new technologies in the French Basque Country (Aquitaine region). Its main objective is to encourage the information society and facilitate the appropriation of digital applications with local authorities, institutions, companies and other stakeholders in the planning of the economic development of the territory. Its missions are organized around four areas of work: - Support business performance through the development of digital technology and appropriation of ICT uses (Information and Communications Technology) - Encourage institutions and communities to carry out or support innovative digital projects - Develop a range of digital applications - Accompany the structuration of sectors or economic groups by using digital technology At the heart of Izarbel, the science and technology park of the Basque Coast, ANTIC mobilizes a network of stakeholders from diverse backgrounds (political and institutional managers, stakeholders in high education, in technology transfer and in SME/SMIs) to arise new projects, promote innovation in the French Basque Country and improve the competitiveness of the territory. ANTIC's role in this project is based on the coordination of the activities (such as, designing a pedagogical methodology for promoting entrepreneurship in school environments and designing the technological tools that will support this methodology), carrying out the experimentation of the pedagogical module of entrepreneurship by constituting the network of stakeholders, and finally, taking part in the development and definition of the new educational model of entrepreneurship and its dissemination.

Description of the project	Young Entrepreneurial Skills ICT (YESict): Developing entrepreneurial skills in Young People thanks to new technologies. The project is based on transmitting, thanks to an innovative way, attitudes and skills which are essential for entrepreneurship from childhood. Nowadays, entrepreneurship is clearly identified as a way to foster economic and employment growth. In addition, global orientations, as well as European or national orientations, encourage programs for the development of entrepreneurship skills of young people. Moreover, new technologies have changed work conditions and our everyday life. They provide real time access to an infinite amount of knowledge, and they allow developing new teaching resources (through new formats such as videos, serious games) creating new methods for more efficient teaching. Hence, the objectives of this project are: Develop entrepreneurship from childhood Experiment new technological methods and tools Create and disseminate a new teaching model for the development of entrepreneurship through ICT Thus, the expected results are: Pedagogical methodology for promoting entrepreneurship in school environments Technological tools as a support of the methodology Bring social reality of entrepreneurs from childhood Promoting entrepreneurship with an equal opportunities perspective, regardless of gender
